## **REFLECTION QUESTIONS**

Respond to the following questions in a 2- to 3-page essay format and submit to your professor for grading.

- 1. Why did Beane's focus on the statistical side of baseball make such a powerful difference for the A's? How did focusing on the numbers over the off-field behaviors produce such a positive result?
- 2. One of the greatest challenges Billy Beane faced in his approach was resistance from the conventional wisdom and traditional management decision-making from MLB veterans and team executives. What strategies did he effectively use to overcome these objections? How might these same strategies apply to other forms of business?
- 3. Beane hiring Peter Brand, an economics major fresh out of Yale and low on the Cleveland Indians' totem pole, to be his assistant general manager was a big risk or was it? What are some of the pros and cons of hiring new management talent with great potential, similarly to how he hired his players.
- 4. Considering Beane's statistical approach, what are the pros and cons of his strategy for effectively managing the **long-term** success of his team?
